SUBMITTING NOMINATIONS FOR THE

SACSCOC LEADERSHIP AND SERVICE AWARDS

The success the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools Commission on Colleges (SACSCOC) has experienced as an accrediting agency is due in large part to the many volunteers who staff evaluation and special committees, as well as those who serve in various leadership positions.

Each year, SACSCOC recognizes one individual who has, through his or her leadership, helped to strengthen the accreditation process in our region and five individuals who have demonstrated outstanding service to SACSCOC.

Procedures for the selection of these individuals:

- Nominations for the Distinguished Leadership Award may be made only by CEOs (presidents/chancellors) of member institutions, members of the SACSCOC Board of Trustees, and SACSCOC staff.
- Nominations for the Service Awards may be made by CEOs (presidents/chancellors) of member institutions, Visiting Committee Chairs, past SACSCOC Board Chairs, members of the SACSCOC Board of Trustees, and SACSCOC staff.
- Nominations for both the Leadership and Service awards will be forwarded to the Executive Council for review and final decision.
- Formal announcement of the Executive Council's selections for the awards will be made at the Second General Session held at the SACSCOC Annual Meeting in December where an appropriate token of recognition will be presented.

Restrictions:

- Former service on the SACSCOC Board of Trustees will not, in and of itself, qualify one to be considered for the Leadership Award.
- No sitting member of the SACSCOC Board of Trustees may be considered for either the Leadership or Service Award.
- No attempt will be made to select individuals on the basis of any criteria other than the value of their service to SACSCOC.
- The Executive Council's final selections will not be publicly announced until the Second General Session at the SACSCOC Annual Meeting.

Anyone who is or has been active in the work of SACSCOC, except for current members of the SACSCOC Board of Trustees, is eligible for nomination and consideration.
