Starting From the Beginning: Quest for Progression Improvement

In order to impact overall undergraduate, degree-seeking student retention and graduation over time, the South College Quality Enhancement Plan *Starting From the Beginning: Quest for Progression Improvement (QPi)* seeks to improve the percentage of undergraduate, degree-seeking students progressing from first to second quarter of their academic program.

The learning outcome has a central focus: Undergraduate degree-seeking student progression from first to second quarter will improve.

To achieve the mission and learning outcome, the following objectives have been established relating to the components of the Plan.

- #1 •The pass rate for SCC 1010 College Management will increase.
- #2 •The percentage of first term undergraduate, degree-seeking students progressing from first to second term will increase.
- #3 •Student Success Advisors (SSAs) will complete required proactive advising responsibilities for first-term undergraduate, degree-seeking students.
- #4 •Outreach protocols to students appearing on term At-Risk Reports will be completed by SSAs for first-term undergraduate, degree-seeking students.
- #5 •Training for SSAs will occur formally on a quarterly basis and focus on advancing skills.
- #6 •Specific course training for SCC 1010 College Management faculty will occur prior to teaching responsibilities.
- #7 •Student Pre-Self Assessment scores regarding metacognition, noncognitive, and cognitive skills at the beginning of SCC 1010 College Management will be lower than scores on the Post-Self Assessment.
- #8 •The percentage of first-term students appearing on an At-Risk Report who progress to the second term will increase.

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
