-Substantive Change – may require audits

- -News headlines media

<u>Reaffirmation Timelines</u>—your institution's next reaffirmation & level <u>www.sacscoc.org</u>

<u>Compliance Certification</u> - two years' financial audits/reviews including recent financial aid

audit

<u>Fifth year requires (at a minimum) audits of</u> federal <u>and</u> state aid

CONSIDER BUILDING A RELATIONSHIP WITH...

Your Auditor

- Share due dates for SACSCOC audits
- Identify bottlenecks
- Schedule work
- Ask them what they need
- Tell them what you need



REAFFIRMATION PROCESS

Compliance Certification

- Reviewed by Off-Site Committee (virtually)
 - If noncompliant, write Focused
 Report



Focused Report

- Reviewed by On-Site Committee (visits your institution)
 - If noncompliant, write **Response Report**



Response Report

- Reviewed by SACSCOC Board
 - If noncompliant, write Monitoring Report
 - Sanctions of Warning or Probation Possible
 - Decisions Public
 - Drop Possible (unusual)
 - Can add standards



WHY DO YOU CARE?

Need most recent audit when CC is due Need to work around auditor schedule Need to get closed quickly Need to think ahead about reconciliations Need to think about resolving findings

REAFFIRMATION / BOARD ACTION

SACSCOC decisions become public

Noncompliance with a CR requires sanction

Noncompliance requires additional reports

SACSCOC Finance Evaluators adjust for: Pensions, OPEB, Compensated Absences

-adjust UNAEP -obligations, deferred inflows/outflows -adjust operational outcomes for allocations

The three-legged stool...Positive Operational Outcomes

- Operational Revenue
- <u>Add</u> Nonoperating Revenue
- <u>Less</u> Expenses
- <u>Add</u> back Depreciation



The three-legged stool... Positive Operational Cash Flows

- Operational Cash Flows
- Plus Noncapital Cash Flows



The three-legged stool...Positive and improving UNAEP

- Trend must be multi-year
- Change should be examined
- SACSCOC definition of operational resources



This standard looks at internal controls

Use your REPORT ON AUDIT here

Findings require external verification of resolution

ALL INSTITUTIONS 13.4 Control of Finances

Requires audit of federal <u>and</u> state financial aid audits

Requires evidence of compliance with Title IV (through lack of findings in the above) AUDITS OF STATE FINANCIAL AID FREQUENTLY MISSING

DOES NOT REQUIRE / DO NOT SEND

Your Program Participation Agreement Your USDOE correspondence Your ECAR, IPEDs Internal Audits

No requirement for "most recent"

ALL INSTITUTIONS 13.6 Federal & State Responsibilities

Adequate Physical Facilities and Resources *"that appropriately serve"*

-surveys of faculty and staff -space / capacity studies -campus master plans -capital campaigns -areas of concern -etc. Resource Manual has list of ideas

Technological Infrastructure

-must be discussed here

ALL INSTITUTIONS 13.7 Physical Resources

In <u>addition</u> to the general response to 13.8 MUST include:

Information related to USDOE Office of Civil Rights investigations alleging sexual violence

Should discuss any since last reaffirmation

If there are none, say so

See Resource Manual for language

INSTITUTIONS 13.8 Institutional Environment

How is your institution providing guidance to students on managing their debt and finances?

DO NOT SEND

Exit Counseling Information Entrance Counseling Information Any Title IV related information

This is not a Title IV standard
